Registration:

Tuesday May 2, 2017 at drop off of artwork at the Peter B. Yeomans Cultural Centre from 5:00 – 8:30 pm

Drop off: Tuesday May 2nd, 2017 from 5:00 p.m. to 8:30 pm at the PBYCC. Limited space available.

Hanging: Wednesday May 3rd, 2017 from 10:00 am to 4:00 pm.

Vernissage: Thursday May 4th, 2017 from 7:00 pm to 9:00 p.m.

Exhibition: Friday May 5th, Saturday May 6th and Sunday May 7th from 10:00 am to 5:00 pm.

Taking down: Sunday May 7th from 5:00 pm to 8:00 pm MAXIMUM

Eligibility Criteria:

- Must be a DAA member
- Must complete a **registration form**
- **Must pay the \$5 registration fee by** cheque or cash
- Must sign up for surveillance duty or as a volunteer for the delivery, hanging or taking down of artwork.
- **Registration will become invalid if you have not signed up for surveillance duty or to help with the receipt, hanging or the taking down of artwork.**

Requirements:

- One to two miniatures (artwork)
- **Maximum 10 (h)x 10 (w) inches** (including frame if framed).
- Artwork that needs protection must be framed with a glass covering. Glass clip frames are not acceptable (Examples: watercolours, pastels, or drawings).
- For all other artwork, framing is not compulsory however it must be presented professionally. Adhesive tape on the sides of the artwork is prohibited.
- Only wall mountable artwork will be accepted
- All mediums are welcome however it must be of an artistic format and not of an “arts & crafts” nature.
- Your artwork may be for sale or indicate “private collection”. The DAA retains no percentage of the sale.
- Original artwork only, otherwise indicate “study”
- The artwork’s subject matter must be socially acceptable and presented in municipal type of exhibition.
- The **artist’s name and title of the artwork must be clearly written on the back of the artwork.**
- The artwork must be equipped with a **wire for hanging.**
